#### MAP DESCRIPTION

- 1 PLAYGROUND AND NATURE EXPLORATION ZONE**  
The two playgrounds would be located adjacent to the parking lot. The playground entrances will be located off of the central walkway and between the playground shelter or shade structure. This will help to create separation from the parking lot and can feature strategic landscaping and fencing. The nature exploration zone will offer a different experience from the main playground with the use of natural materials.
- 2 SHADED SPORT COURT ENTRY AREA**  
The southwest corner of the existing basketball courts will be utilized as a small plaza space. This plaza will feature seating and shade and will be a place to wait for courts to open up or rest between games. Moving the entrance farther from the east side of the courts would encourage park visitors to park in the designated parking lot. This area is located next to the picnic area and shelter which can provide a longer term seating option.
- 3 SLEDDING HILL WITH FITNESS STAIRS AND ADA ACCESSIBLE SWITCHBACK**  
The existing sledding hill will be enhanced with the addition of a set of stairs and an ADA accessible switchback. This will improve circulation and accessibility to the top of the hill. At the top of the sledding hill there will be a small plaza space to sit or begin your journey down the hill whether rolling, running, or sledding. Along the ADA accessible switchback there will be boulders that will create an opportunity for climbing and nature inspired play.
- 4 POTENTIAL FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS**  
The fitness trail and pump track identified on the plan will be potential future improvements. The pump track will be a unique feature for the Elmhurst Park District. This will offer a place for kids of all ages to ride bikes, scooters, rollerblades or skateboards. The fitness trail will be geared towards adult 18+. There will be stations spread out along the trail with a variety of fitness equipment, including, strength and cardio.
- 5 WOODLAND GARDEN WITH ELEVATED BOARDWALK**  
The unused space in the eastern portion of the property can be utilized as an educational area or a quiet retreat. The existing vegetation and topography can be utilized to create a wetland, woodland habitat. This can feature educational signage about native flora and fauna or stormwater management. At the entrance to the boardwalk a small shade structure will act as a place to sit and enjoy the scenery or a place for a small group to gather.
