## about the park

### 385 E. Van Buren Street

Butterfield Park is located north of Butterfield Road. The park can be accessed via E. Van Buren Street, which leads directly to the main parking lot. The park can also be accessed farther north, near the intersection of Linden and E. Adams Street, where more parking can be found.

Butterfield Park features a soccer field, three lighted tennis courts (one court with Pickleball lines), the Playground for Everyone, covered picnic shelter, and four baseball diamonds. One of these baseball diamonds is lighted and regulation size, and serves as the home field of the Elmhurst College Bluejays men's baseball team. The main walking path will take you .48 miles around the diamond.
